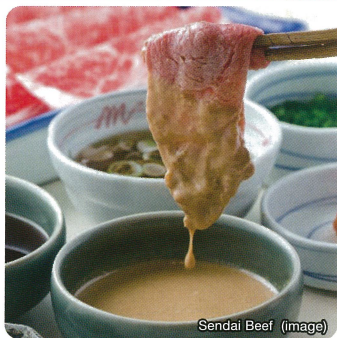


9 Miyagi Top-rank Wagyu Beef Shabu-shabu Meal Plan (Sendai Beef)
