





Today you will be visiting Tohoku's first UNESCO World Heritage Site – **Hiraizumi**. Established in 850, **Chusonji** is Hiraizumi's most famous attraction and a visit here will bring you back to the days of Tohoku's Golden Age. The Konjikido is quite literally the crown jewel of Chusonji and the opulence of Tohoku's past can be seen from its hall that has been completely covered in gold leaf. When in late Spring, one of the most-visit spots has to be **Tenshochi Park**. Over 10,000 cherry trees line the Kitakami River forming a sakura tunnel of over 2 kilometres and earning the park a spot among Japan's top 100 places for sakura-viewing. Many come in search of these fragile pink blossoms that sprawl over an area of 283 hectares, which is equivalent to 62 Tokyo Domes. Make sure to get your cameras and megawatt smiles ready for today!

Hotel: Onyado Ichiraku (Hot Spring) or similar
This morning, you will visit Mt. Zao, one of Tohoku's most prominent mountains. Straddling the Miyagi and Yamagata prefectures, this active volcano is famous for its crater lake that changes its jewelled-tones based on the sun rays. Continuing on to **Rieshakujii** in the afternoon, you will be able to catch stunning views of the mountain valley below and soak in the refreshing Spring mountain air...that is, if you are able to survive the 1,015 steps climb up the mountain slope. Today you will be visiting Tohoku's first UNESCO World Heritage Site – **Hiraizumi**. Established in 850, Chusonji is Hiraizumi's most famous attraction and a visit here will bring you back to the days of Tohoku's Golden Age. The Konjikido is quite literally the crown jewel of Chusonji and the opulence of Tohoku's past can be seen from its hall that has been completely covered in gold leaf. After that, we will bring you to two beautiful gorges in the afternoon. **Naruko Gorge** is one of the Tohoku Region's most scenic gorges, and around late October each year, it transforms into one of the region's most popular autumn colour spots. You can also enjoy autumn leaf viewing at another spectacular gorge called **Genbikei**. Maple, Rowan, and Ginkgo leaves make the gorge a belt of brocade this time of the year. Admire the colour contrast of its gorgeous river flow and the sharp rocks and cliffs.

Previous revisions to this Import Alert dated March 23, April 12, April 14, April 20, April 21, May 9, June 13, July 6, October 21, 2011, February 1, 2012, July 25, 2012 September 9, 2013, February 24, 2015, March 31, 2015, April 3, 2015, July 16, 2015,*** August 4, 2015 and November 17, 2015*** provided updates to the products and/or prefectures subject to detention without physical examination.

On March 11, 2011, an 8.9 magnitude earthquake triggering a 30 ft tsunami struck the Pacific Coast of Japan. The force of the tsunami destroyed a great deal of the infrastructure along portions of the Japanese coast. The most notable damage from the tsunami affected the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear plant. The following prefectures are in the closest proximity to the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear plant: Fukushima, Gunma Ibaraki, and Tochigi.

The Fukushima Daiichi nuclear plant houses several nuclear reactors that pose a potential threat of radiological contamination to the surrounding areas. Due to the public health concerns that are associated with radiation and nuclear contamination, FDA has increased surveillance of regulated products from Japan.

On March 19, 2011, the Japanese Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare confirmed the presence of radioactive iodine contamination in dairy, fresh produce, and infant formula products. Japanese data analyses revealed that the food products measured from March 16-18, 2011, indicated the presence of radioactive iodine was five times the acceptable levels. The elevated levels were identified in products tested in Kawamata Town, Fukushima prefecture and Ibaraki prefecture; areas around the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant.

Though radioactive iodine has a short half-life of about 8 days and decays naturally within a matter of weeks, there is a risk to human health if radioactive iodine in food is absorbed into the human body. If ingested, it can accumulate in and cause damage to the thyroid. Children and young
